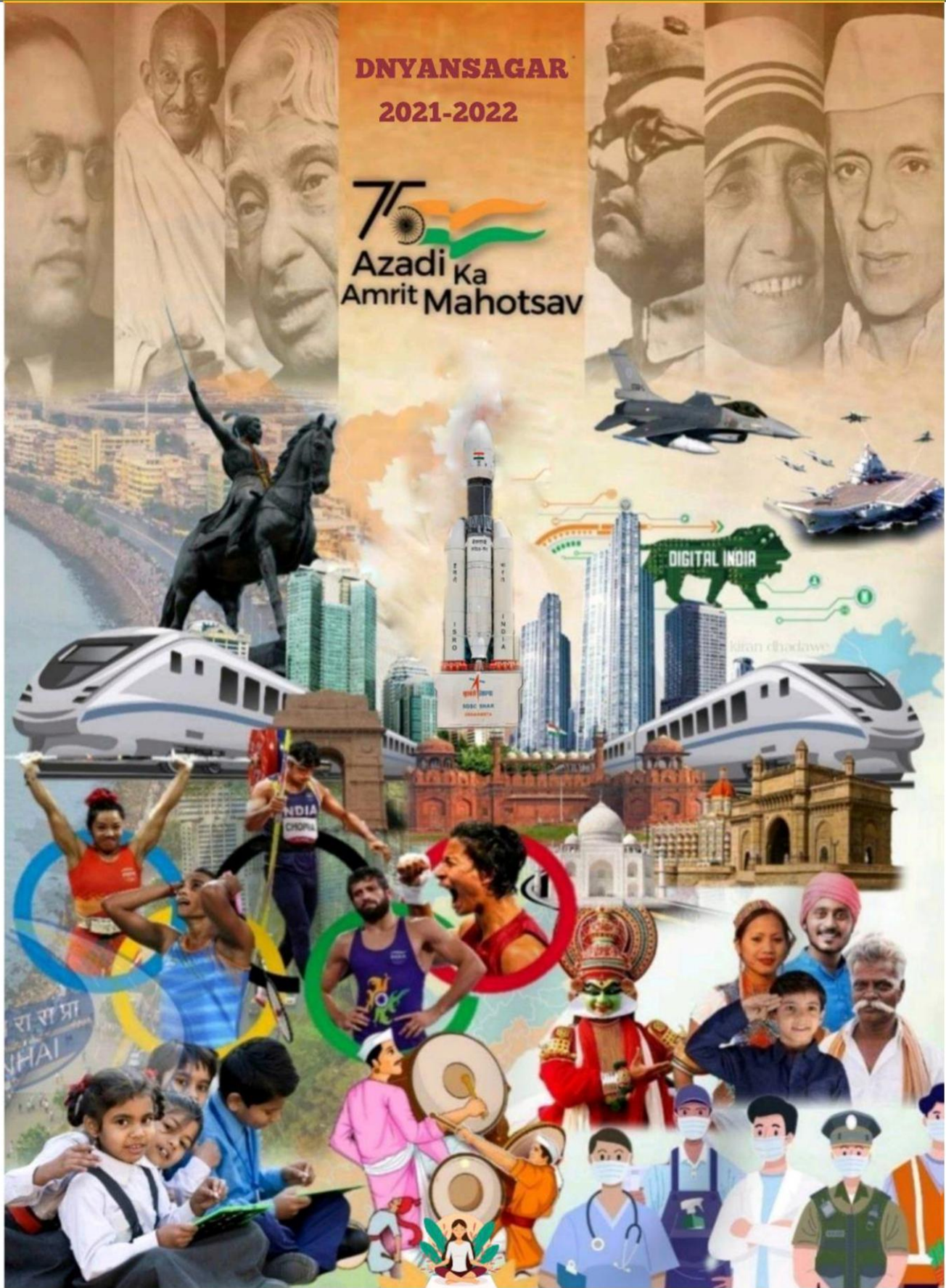

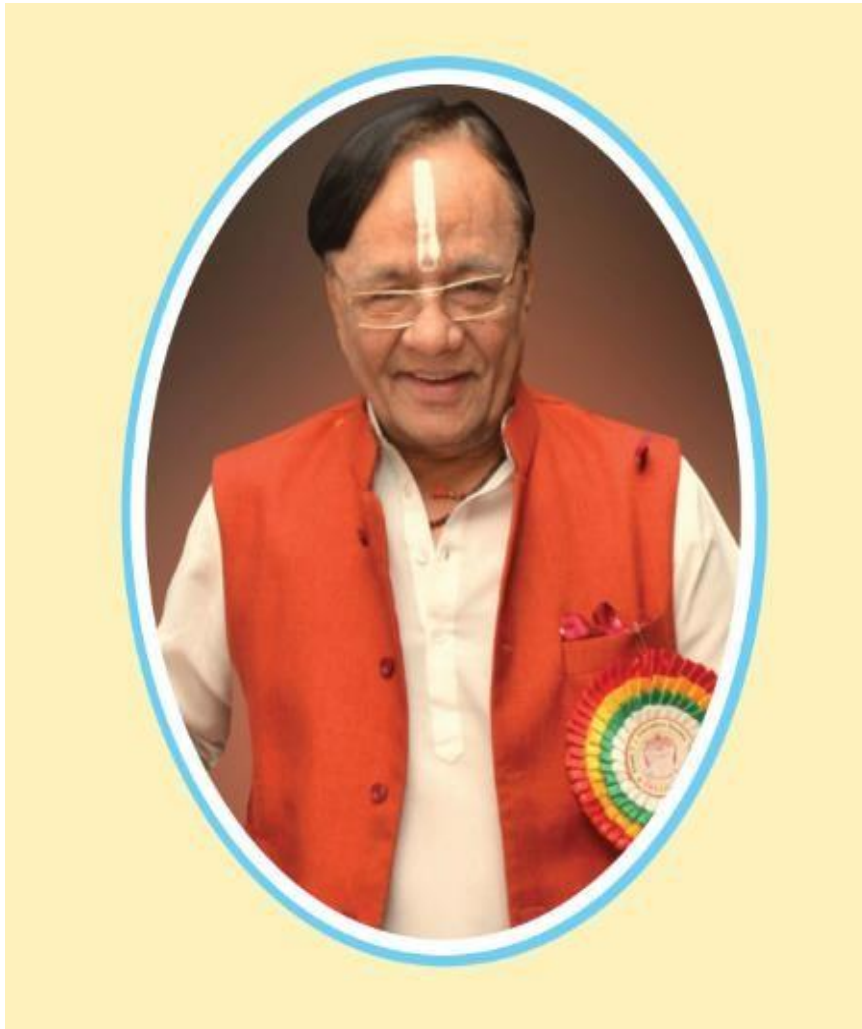

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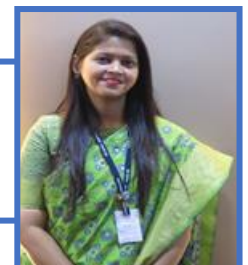
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संपादकीय

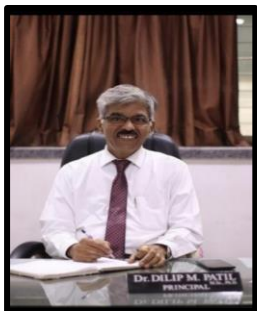

College Annual Report

The college reopened for the academic year on 6th of June 2021. Regular lectures commenced from 13th June. In keeping with the tradition, this year too the results of all streams including the self-financing courses have been extremely good. We have various committees, associations and academic bodies which organize a variety of academic, cultural, social and sports activities. I will briefly enumerate some of the important activities and programs conducted by these associations.

The Economic department along with English department had organized a one day multidisciplinary National Conference on the topic "New dimensions to social and economic development of India in presence of the COVID-19 Pandemic". The Department of Sociology has organized an Intra-collegiate Mock Parliament event in collaboration with the Advance and Slow Learner Committee on the college campus and also held several competitions based on "Dr. Ambedkar's life and contribution to the Making of Modern India", such as the Elocution competition, Essay writing competition, Poetry recitation competition. Department of Business law conducted an online webinar on 'Intellectual property rights' and 'life skills for stress management'.

The institution has initiated the Digital language laboratory which is managed by the English department. It is a unique state of art Solution developed to improve the communication skills of students. Digital language lab in general offers facilities like text, images, audio and video learning. Using the lab students can gain command over their language and gain self-confidence as well. The English department had also Conducted 30 hour's certificate course on Corporate Communications in association with SFC department from 7th to 22nd December, 2021.

The Art circle under the guidance of CA Kanak Jayawant conducted various activities such as Gurupurnima, Intercollegiate Rakhi making, Rangoli competition. On 21st November 15 students participated in a skit for senior citizens project of Anand Nilayam old age home. The skit was performed at Kashinath Ghanekar auditorium. The students were awarded with certificates. The IQAC has initiated steps for enhancing the teaching and learning experience with the help of latest technology. Dr. Himanshi Mansukhani as IQAC Coordinator- Organized IQAC core committee, Criteria In-charges meetings and Documentation committee meeting required for SSR documents.

In the academic year 2021-22, Entrepreneurship Development Cell in collaboration with NSS Unit of the college had organized a crash course on "Avenues for Women Entrepreneurship". "Gender Equity and Promotion through HELM Program" was jointly organized by WDC, DLLE, Entrepreneurship Development Cell in association with Heartfulness Institute. The N.S.S Units of the college under the leadership programme officers, Mr.A.O.Khadse and Mrs.Mukta Mangalvedhekar had conducted several social and altruistic activities. International Yoga Day was celebrated on 21st June 2021 a session on "Yoga for Life" was conducted

online for the students by ex-student and Fitness guru Shri Girish Kadam. Total 21 male and 13 female students had participated in the session. It had also organized many activities such as Tree plantation blood donation camp, Fit India Run activity, Organ donation awareness, Gandhi Jayanthi, street plays, disaster management, blood donation, Covid vaccination drive, voters day and International womens day. The college has undertaken 'Tree plantation' programme with an aim to promote green environment. The students of the NSS unit plants saplings within the campus and also travel to different places in Thane for the same.

The Gymkhana committee under the guidance of Prof. M.N.N Varade Sir had organized a NKT-interclass Sports Quiz competition for all the students on 23rd December 2021. In this academic year Mr. Siddhesh Sawant student of SYBcom from the college got selected in Senior Nationals and Interstate Championships Table Tennis competition which was held at Sai Indoor Stadium Shilong, Meghalaya from 18th April to 25th April 2022. The Women Development Cell under the convenorship of Dr. Pallavi A. Shah had conducted various activities like online safety and protection of women in cyberspace, WDC in association with DLLE organized 3 – days (28th October 2021 to 30th October 2021) workshop on Warli Painting, national level 30 hours certificate course (1st February 2022 to 18th February 2022) on “Gender Equity and Promotion through Heartfulness Enabled Leadership Mastery Program”, Health and hygiene, Gender equality.

Entrepreneurship cell in collaboration with NSS unit of the college organised 6 days crash course for the female students of the college from 9th August, 2021 to 14th August, 2021 on topics like cupcake baking, glass painting, mehendi, basics of makeup and hairstyling. WDC, DLLE, Entrepreneurship Development Cell in association with Heartfulness Institute organized a national level 30 hours certificate course (1st February 2022 to 18th February 2022) on “Gender Equity and Promotion through Heartfulness Enabled Leadership Mastery Program”.

We are grateful for the immense support from parents, alumni and students who are the strong pillars of our institution. On behalf of the Management, staff and student council of the college, I thank each and every one who was instrumental in achieving this success and expect the same for years to come.

Student Induction Programme:

Department of English

The Department teaches Business Communication to F.Y.B.Com and S.Y.B.A students and Communication Skills in English to F.Y.B.A students. The objectives of the subjects are to develop among learners an awareness of complexities of the communication process, effective listening skills, oral skills and writing skills among students and ability to communicate through ICT. The department is happy to announce the installation and commencement of a state-of-the-art digital language laboratory with 30 consoles from the current academic year.

Curriculum delivery and academic activities: The department has imparted knowledge and skills as prescribed by the Board of Studies English, University of Mumbai. Apart from regular lectures and tutorials, students have learnt through interactions, experiences, planned and unplanned activities conducted by the department. The faculty of the department have given assignments and projects given to students. Books, reading materials, audio-visual content was provided to students for better understanding of the syllabus. Different assessment methods such as assignments, important question-answer sessions and open book test was used to evaluate attainment of student learning goals. Additionally, learning support, advice, guidance, interaction, mentorship, participative and collaborative learning was provided.

- Conducted orientation sessions for students of all streams regarding the functions and usage of the language laboratory.

Digital Language Laboratory

A Digital language laboratory has been set up in this academic year. Thirty computers have been installed with a unique State of Art solution developed to improve the communication skills of students. Using the laboratory, students can improve the command over their language, gain confidence and get ready for real world challenges like facing interviews, doing presentation, expressing thoughts, etc. It involves students to actively participate in language learning exercises and get more practice than otherwise possible in a traditional classroom environment. The Digital Language lab offers following facilities:

- Text, images, audio and video can easily be integrated; teachers can alter materials to fit their requirements.
- Learners can record their own voice and play back the recordings, interact with each other and the teacher, and store results.
- Teachers can intervene and control the learners' computers via the teacher's console, track of learners' work, etc.
- Self-access for independent learning which includes access to resources outside class

In the Student Console, the student has the facility of listening, speaking, repeating, comparing and writing (typing) the lessons assigned in the class by the teacher. The students can log into the teacher's console by typing in their name and number. Students will be getting the pre-recorded lessons from the teacher console after logging in. Student can call and communicate with the teacher from the student console without disturbing others.

- Students listen to the lessons pre-recorded by experts
- Automatically receive lessons from teacher console and can use these lessons for personal practice
- Student can record his own voice and compare the correctness of his/her pronunciation
- Self-assessment at the end of each assignment is submitted to the Teacher console for evaluation
- Student can communicate with the Teacher through Text / Audio / Video Chat
- Text to Speech Facility for pronunciation
- Facility to use the in-built Dictionary

College has Department of Business Law with following objectives as provided by **University of Mumbai**.

Objectives :

1. To provide the brief idea about the frame work of Indian Business Laws.
2. To orient students, about the legal aspects of business.
3. To familiarize the students with case law studies related to Business Laws of Semester III and IV.

Academic Details of the Year

- First term of the academic year started on 14th June, 2021. After receiving admitted students data, what's app groups were formed. Business Law lectures and Foundation Course Lectures were conducted as per the allotment through zoom platform. Google classroom was created and all course content and relevant material was shared with students. Google quizzes were conducted on syllabus as per the requirements. Remedial lectures were taken before ATKT exams.

Activities Conducted During the Year

1. National Quiz on Intellectual Property Rights' was conducted on 30th July, 2021. All the participants who scored minimum 40% marks were awarded with E-Certificates. Total 526 participants successfully participated in the Quiz.
2. 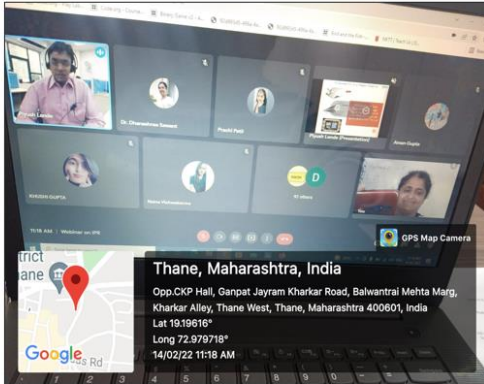

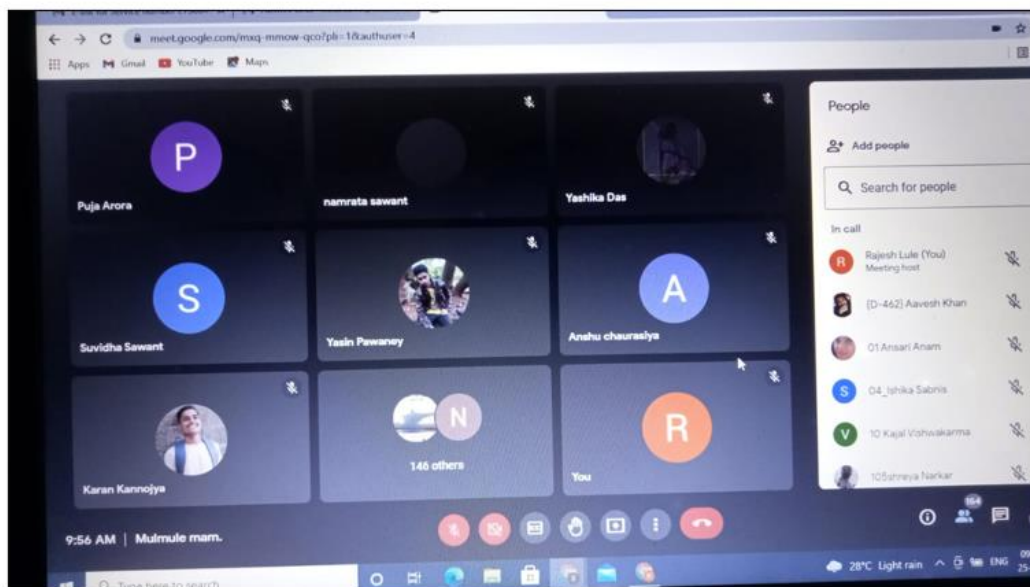

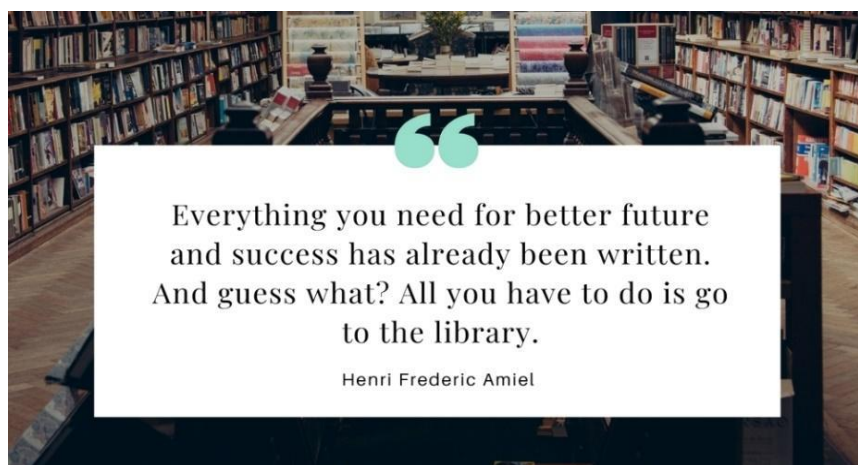
As of today with these additions we have a total collection of **35000** reading materials containing text books, reference books, bound volumes, e-resources, and serials.
