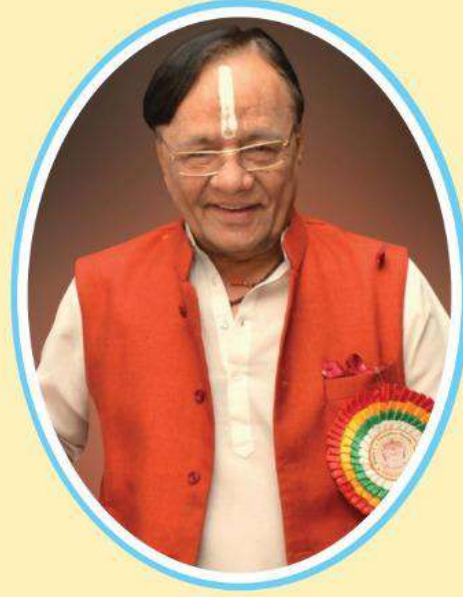

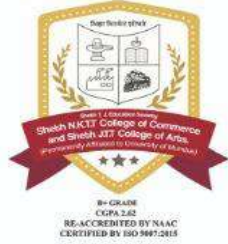

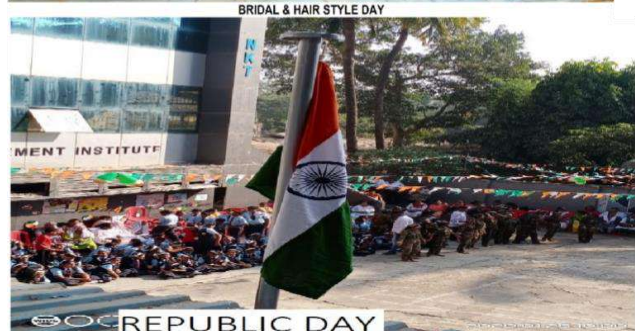

On 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2019 all NSS program officer, NSS members, student volunteers and peon reached the place with volunteers in the morning. The camp was inaugurated by Samaj Sevak of the village Shri. Datta Rao and Gramsevak Shri. Hemant Patil and Police Patil of Sarmal village Shri. Ramdas Rao. NSS programme officer Prof Anil Khadse addressed the function and told about NSS camp and activities in the camp. 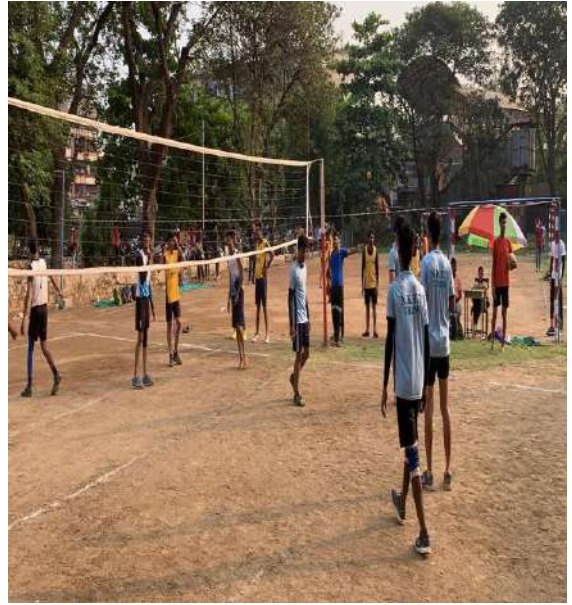

# COMMERCE LABORATORY

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- **Introduction-**

Now-a-days, commerce and business education is the most attractive degree course due to the quick placement and attractive salary obtains by the candidates. Generally, employers prefer commerce graduates because conceptual/theoretical knowledge of business which is useful to the organizational activities and recruitment of such commerce degree candidates reduces the cost of training.

*The Commerce laboratory is a concept, wherein learners practice their theoretical knowledge gained in the classroom. In addition, learners carry on more and more experiments.* Mock commerce and business activities can be undertaken in laboratory. By this method of learning and practicing, learners will develop self-confidence of running a business profitably and understand the practical difficulties. In order to meet the challenging needs of business environment, it is insufficient for learners to be theoretically sound, they must also be exposed to the external world in a dynamic way to face practical situations.

Commerce Lab provides practical exposure of the processes and procedures followed by organizations in conducting commercial practices. The lab provides practical orientation to the learners by linking the subject syllabi with practical training in the lab. If the Commerce Laboratory is well-equipped with the latest teaching aids such as projector, video camera and Laptop. ## संस्काराची ताकद
